Summary of the grant call 8.12.2015 in HCMC

E IPP

Innovation Partnership Program

- IPP is an ODA Program co-financed by the Governments of Finland and Vietnam until 2018
- Boosts sustainable economic growth in Vietnam by increased production and export of innovative products and services
- Scales up innovation training and improves local support mechanisms for new innovative companies targeting international markets
- Provides seed funding via Grant Schemes
- Capacity building through entrepreneurship and innovation training programs

IPP's Past Activities



- Seed grant and Innovation Accelerator Program (IAP) for 18 new innovative growth company projects and 4 innovation system development projects
- Training of Trainers (ToT) program organised for 12 innovation coaches
- Core curriculum on innovation and entrepreneurship initiated and tested in the above training programs
- Institutional and policy support





IPP's Main Support 2016-2017

- New grant call for startup ecosystem development projects
- Additional grant to support the most successful projects in IPP's project portfolio
- Call for universities and other educational organisations for developing their innovation and entrepreneurship training and ecosystem building related offering
- Mentoring facility program and connections

Call to be open in Jan - Feb 2016



Support for Consortiums

- Consortium = at least three organizations who develop together new services and concepts to help startups & new innovative growth companies
- Each grant receiver must be an entity that is registered legally in Vietnam
 - The Vietnamese legal entity is needed before signing the IPP grant contract
 - Foreign ownership is welcome, too



Examples of Potential Projects

- creation of new services for incubator
- development of a new accelerator
- planning of a new funding program
- adding services for startups to science park
- initiating a cluster growth program
- developing regional platform
- other high value services for innovative growth companies and startups



Soft Support for Projects

- mentoring and advisory
- national and international connections
- opportunity to participate in an online startup ecosystem platform piloted by IPP
- opportunity to apply for additional grant from IPP in the end of 2016.

E IPP

Grant

- Covers human resource costs (both internal and external)
- 70% reimbursement of acceptable costs created and paid in the project
- The maximum to be paid to each consortium is 1,150,000,000 VND (50 000 EUR)
- Project costs can be accepted for reimbursement from April/May till end of 2016



Acceptable Project Costs

YES

 IPP funds only human resources related costs, such as salaries, expert services, travel, mentor and advisory services

NO

 IPP does not accept cost of equipment and consumables or running costs of the organizations



Example: Danang Consortium

Da Nang Entrepreneurship and Innovation Ecosystem project is conducted by the collaboration and cooperation of three main allied partners:

- UD-CIT: the University of Da Nang College of IT
- DISED: Da Nang Institute for Socio-Economic Dev.
- 9StartLab team

The project builds incubators and supportive ecosystems in universities and the city of Danang, with the mission to promote Danang city to be one of the Vietnam's leading startup communities and to be an international commercial center of Asean by 2025.



Example: Key Success Factors

- 3. Secure financial resources
- 4. Contribute to public policies in line with the reality and perspectives of an increasingly globalized world
- 5. Provide competent, innovative and knowledgeable project team and management
- 6. Train innovative, entrepreneurial and committed individuals to conduct the operations
- 7. Select the right clients
- 8. Provide proper infrastructure and services that support new business ventures
- 9. Establish a network of relationships and alliances
- 10. Maintain an understanding of current technological and market trends
- 11. Identify and develop strategies for your beneficiaries to secure financial resources

Will cover:

- Market needs
- Solution
- Team and Consortium
- Financial capabilities
- Project budget
- Project implementation plan



Evaluation of Proposals

- IPP will evaluate proposals in open and transparent manner
- External international evaluation team will interview Applicants and evaluate Proposals
- Evaluation results will be public by April 2016
- One joint proposal + one for each organization applying for grant money

Contracting



- To be negotiated in April 2016
- Grant support Contract will be signed in April/May 2016
- All costs eligible for reimbursement are from April/May to 31 Dec 2016
- Each member of Consortium who gets grant money will sign his own contract with IPP

How to Prepare for the Call



- Have passion to support startups
- Build your consortium of min 3 partners
- Build a core team of minimum of 3 people
- Work on a joint vision and workplan
- Define what to do in the 6-8 month project
- Communicate with IPP representatives
 - Submit your Expression of Interest as soon as you have an idea about a potential project
